Location: Neath Road, Collie

All campsites are *unpowered*.

Dogs are welcome on a leash, but please be mindful that 1080 baiting is carried out in parts of the region.

### Mick Murray and David Ugle Campgrounds

Lake Kepwari offers 53 large camping sites for vehicles of all sizes. Campsites are compacted gravel and roads within the campsites are unsealed compacted gravel. Suitable for caravans, camper trailers, RVs and tents.

Facilities include:

- Toilets
- Non-potable water (not suitable for drinking)
- Picnic tables
- Gas BBQs
- Designated fire pits

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## Wellington National Park

Location: Wellington Dam Road, Worsley  
(Off Coalfields Highway)

Bookings for all Wellington National Park campsites must be made prior to arrival online at [parkstay.dbca.wa.gov.au](http://parkstay.dbca.wa.gov.au)

All campsites are *unpowered*.

No pets are permitted within Wellington National Park.

### Potters Gorge Campground

The campground accommodates large vehicles, caravans, tents and camper trailers. It's also a popular spot to boat and water ski. Potters Gorge has 60 camp sites.

Facilities include:

- Toilets (non-flush)
- Non-potable water
- Picnic tables
- Gas BBQs
- Fire pits
- Dump point

### Honeymoon Pool Campground

This campground is designed for tents and swags only due to the narrow winding roads. It has 20 tent sites to pick from that vary in size for families, small groups and individuals.

Facilities include:

- Toilets
- Non-potable water (not suitable for drinking)
- Picnic tables
- Gas BBQs
- Fire pits
- Wood BBQs (bring your own wood)



### Gelcoat Campground (at Honeymoon Pool)

Designed for lightweight camping (tents and swags), there are 8 sites available. Campers park their vehicles at a central location and not at the campsite. Camping is along the rivers edge.

Facilities include:

- Toilets (non-flush)
- Picnic table
- Communal fire pit

### Stones Brook Campground (at Honeymoon Pool)

Is a 17 tent campground for tents and swags. These campsites are more secluded with more space between camp sites. Note there are *no* camp fires permitted at any time of the year.

Facilities include:

- Toilets
- Non-potable water (not suitable for drinking)
- Picnic tables
- Gas BBQs
- Gas Pot Boiler
- Undercover campers kitchen

## Stockton Lake

Location: Piavaninni Road, Collie

No prior bookings required, however the Ranger will collect a small fee each day.

All campsites are *unpowered*.

Dogs are welcome on a leash, but please be mindful that 1080 baiting is carried out in parts of the region.

### Campground

Even though there are no designated individual campsites, the area is perfect for caravans, camper trailers and tents. It's a popular spot for boating, skiing and swimming. However due to low PH levels in the water, swimming is at your own risk.

Facilities include:

- Toilets
- Fire pits
- Boat ramp (currently out of use until further notice)

## Glen Mervyn Dam

Location: Collie-Preston Road (18km south of Collie)

No bookings needed and no designated camp spots.

All campsites are *unpowered*.

Dogs are welcome on a leash, but please be mindful that 1080 baiting is carried out in parts of the region.

### Campground

The campsites are located on the western shore of the dam. It's popular for swimming, fishing and water skiing. Camp and cooking fires are not permitted. These campsites are suitable for tent and small campervans as the unsealed track is very narrow.

Facilities include:

- Toilets
- Picnic tables
- Boat ramp
