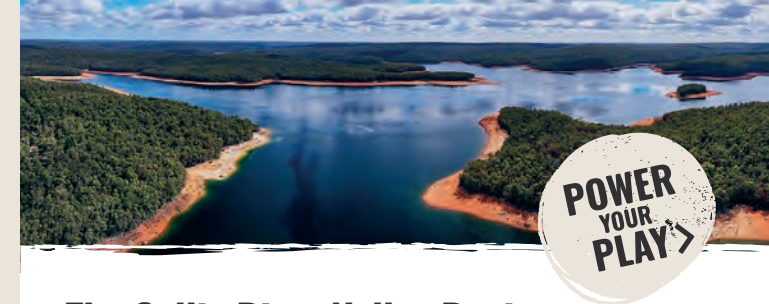
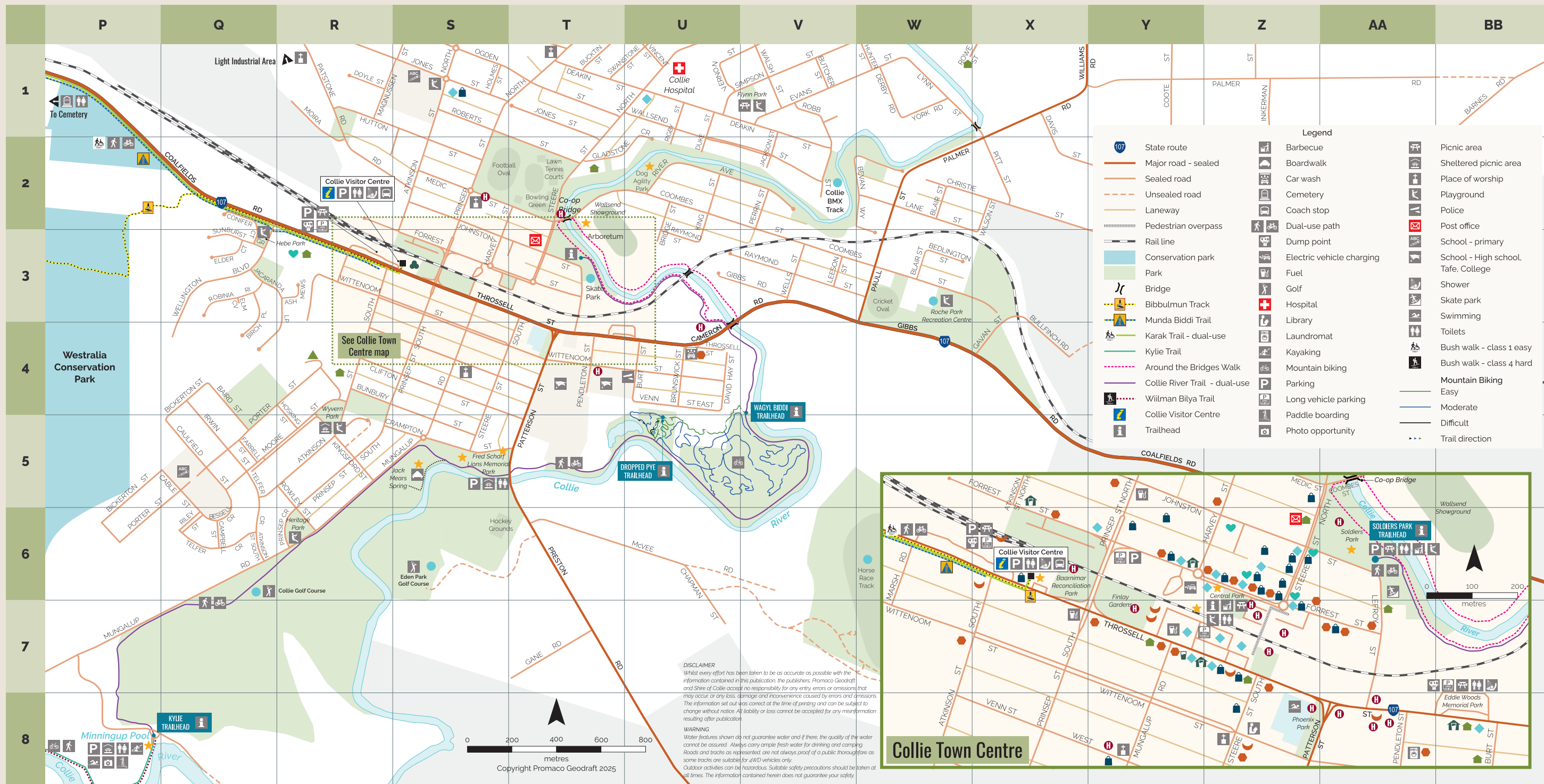
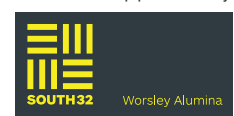

History & Heritage

Step back in time and uncover Collie's rich history and heritage, shaped by coal mining, timber milling, and railways. Founded in 1896, Collie thrives today as a town proud of its past and excited about its future. The **Replica Underground Coal Mine** offers a fascinating look at the lives of miners who built this community, while the **Coalfields Museum** brims with artefacts and stories from days gone by. Train buffs won't want to miss the **Steam Locomotive Museum**, where impressive engines stand as a tribute to Collie's strong railway roots.

Strolling the streets, you'll find heritage-listed buildings standing as proud reminders of Collie's industrious roots. Art in Collie is all about getting involved. With a lively, creative community and plenty of heart, it's as welcoming as the town itself.



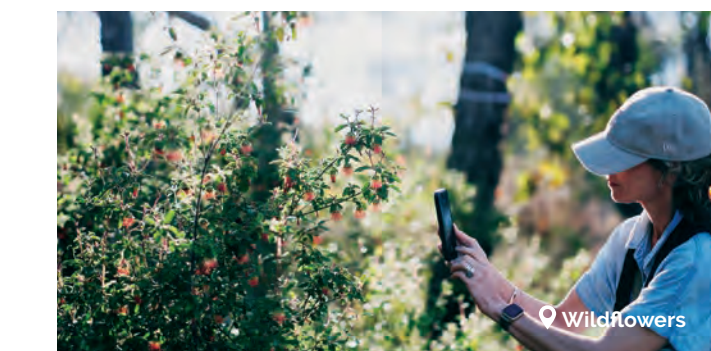

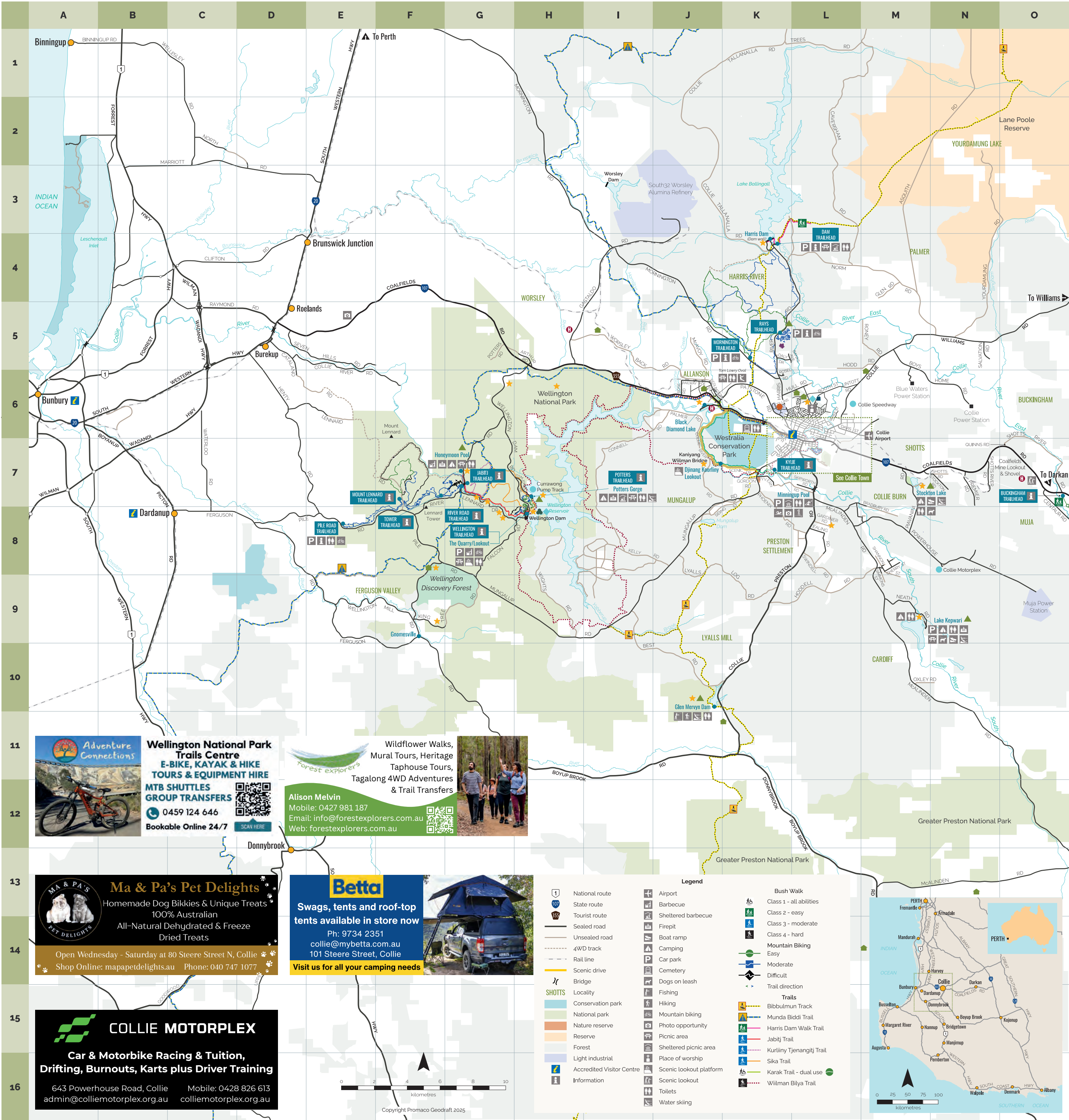


Trail Town & Trails
